


CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE CASA ASIA AWARDS 2026

Casa Asia, a public diplomacy institution composed of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the European Union and Cooperation, the Government of Catalonia, and the City Councils of Barcelona and Madrid, was established in 2001 with the aim of promoting knowledge, dialogue and relations between the Asia-Pacific region and Spain, particularly between their respective civil societies.

The Casa Asia Awards, created in 2004, aim to recognise and promote the work of individuals, entities or projects that excel in their respective fields of activity or that contribute to fostering knowledge, dialogue and relations between Spain and the Asia-Pacific region.

The Casa Asia Awards are presented in four categories: Economy and Business; Politics and Society; Education and Science; and Culture.

Casa Asia hereby announces the call for nominations for the Casa Asia Awards 2026, which will be governed by the following Rules, approved by its Directorate-General.




CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE CASA ASIA AWARDS 2026

Casa Asia announces the 2026 Casa Asia Awards.

The Casa Asia Awards will be conferred upon individuals, entities or projects that stand out or make a significant and exemplary contribution through their work and achievements in the economic, scientific, academic, educational, cultural and social fields.

FIRST - Categories

- **Casa Asia Award for Economy and Business:** for candidates that contribute to strengthening trade, economic or business relations between Spain and the countries of the Asia-Pacific region.
- **Casa Asia Award for Politics and Society:** for candidates that make a significant contribution to the understanding and visibility of the social and political realities of the Asia-Pacific countries, as well as to dialogue between civil societies in Spain and those of the region.
- **Casa Asia Award for Education and Science:** for candidates that contribute in the educational, academic or research fields concerning Asia and the Pacific or their respective languages, as well as those that promote scientific cooperation.
- **Casa Asia Award for Culture:** for outstanding candidates in the artistic field, in any of its forms — visual arts, film, literature, music, etc. — with a thematic or conceptual link to the Asia-Pacific region.





SECOND - Award

The Casa Asia Award consists of a sculpture symbolising the Casa Asia Awards, the work of the artist Joan Esquerdo Ivars, together with an official diploma.

THIRD - Nominations

- Any individual or entity may submit nominations for the Casa Asia Awards in one or more of the four established categories.
- Each nomination must set out the merits of the proposed individual, entity or project. Where appropriate, Casa Asia reserves the right to reassign nominations to a category other than the one initially proposed.
- Although other origins are not excluded, nominations concerning individuals, entities or projects from Spain or from a country in the Asia-Pacific region will be viewed favourably.
- Nominations submitted by individuals or entities seeking an award for themselves or for the organisations they represent will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Nominations must be justified and submitted through the [online form](#) disponible available on the Casa Asia website.



FOURTH - Jury

- The jury will be composed of the Director General of Casa Asia, who will act as Chair, and six members of the institution, representing Casa Asia's different areas of activity: Economy and Business; Politics, Society and Education; Culture and Exhibitions; Diversity and Interculturality; Media Library; and Communication.
- The members of the jury will act with rigour, impartiality and independence.
- The proposed nominations and the jury's deliberations will be confidential.
- Voting is non-transferable and may also be carried out online, in which case it must be submitted by email to the Chair.
- Nominations once submitted may not be modified in any way.
- The award will be granted to only one nomination per category, by majority vote. The Chair will have the casting vote in the event of a tie.



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE CASA ASIA AWARDS 2026

- Among the evaluation criteria, the jury will take into account nominations that have an impact on intercultural dialogue, the building of a diverse and inclusive society, the promotion of innovation, gender equality or any other field of action related to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- Without prejudice to the quality and merits of the nominations, Casa Asia will promote gender balance among award recipients and will seek to reflect diversity among the laureates.
- The jury's decision will be announced within one month through publication of the resolution on Casa Asia's website. Award recipients and those who submitted the selected nominations will also be notified.

FIFTH - Presentation of the Casa Asia Awards

The presentation ceremony of the Casa Asia Awards will take place at an event organised by Casa Asia during the second half of 2026.
